Personal Safety:

- Running, throwing, shouting and any other fooling around is absolutely forbidden and will not be tolerated.
- 2. Secure loose clothing. Hoodies with long drawstrings are very dangerous.
- Tie back long hair if you have to ask it's long enough to tie back.
- 4. Remove all jewellery before entering the shop. Medic alert info stays on.
- 5. Wear only rubber soled, non-slip shoes. No 'high' heels, bare feet or flip flops!
- 6. Eye protection must be worn when we are building.
- 7. Students must never enter the shop unless Mr. Peacock is present.
- 8. Chairs must never be used to climb.
- 9. Personal music devices' earphones (mp3's, I-pods) are a serious hazard & will be not be allowed to be used in the shop.
- 10. Protect your hands. Heat resistant gloves must be worn when using hot glue guns. Leather gloves are also available when using tools.
- 11. Use gloves and tongs to move items on and off hot plates.
- 12. Report any accident or injury to Mr. Peacock immediately. He will administer first aid.
- 13. Bring any personal medical concerns to the attention of Mr Peacock through E-mail or written notice. (glen.peacock@ocdsb.ca)

Good Housekeeping Safe Practices:

- 1. Place all personal belongings safely away from workspaces.
- 2. Never blow sawdust, brush it to the floor and sweep it up.
- 3. Remember to put away tools directly after use and clean work areas constantly.
- 4. Clean up and recycle extra paper appropriately.
- 5. Make sure electrical cords and extension cords will not trip or block anyone.
- 6. Water bottles must be kept safely away from work stations. No food is permitted.
- 7. When you are finished with a tool put it away in the proper place and the proper way. If you don't know where it goes, find out and then put it away.
- 8. When you make a mess, clean it up.

Safe Basic Tool Use:

- 1. Do not distract a person using tools.
- 2. Follow safety procedures as explained and demonstrated by Mr. Peacock, when using tools.
- 3. Use care and common sense when using sharp tools the blade or bit is kept pointing down at all times and keep hands and fingers behind any tool's cutting edge.
- 4. Unplug tools when not in use. Pull the plug and not the cord.
- 5. All stock materials (plastic/wood/metal) must be properly clamped on worktables.
- 6. Use tools only for the purpose for which they are intended. Breaking or damaging equipment, tools or blades as a result of misuse will not be tolerated.
- 7. Pass tools properly from hand to hand, don't toss them or slide them.
- 8. Report any faulty, damaged or defective or mislaid tools to Mr. Peacock immediately.



In the event of a FIRE OR FIRE DRILL

- > Alert Mr. Peacock if he is not aware of it. (He will make a choice about the Fire Alarm.)
- > Do not attempt to use the fire extinguisher
- > Unplug glue guns and other tools you plugged in.
- > Walk quickly and quietly out the door and down staircase G.
- > Exit LDHSS and line up alphabetically with your class at the end of the sports field
- > Wait quietly for your teacher.
- > Mr. P. is the last person out of the class and closes the door.



In the event of an EMERGENCY

> procedure is the same as a fire drill.



In the event of a LOCK DOWN =

- Lock down notification will come from the PA system and/or from Mr. Peacock
- > All windows must be covered
- > Door will be closed & locked.
- Unplug glue guns and other tools you plugged in.
- > Put down your tools safely.
- > Leave your projects and personal belongings.
- > Sit quietly on the floor until 'all clear' is given
